# IN-EUR - Measuring Innovation in European Subregions

The Working Seminar *IN-EUR - Measuring Innovation in European Subregions* is an opportunity to discuss the question of how to improve innovation policy, thanks to innovative methodologies for measurement and evaluation.

Organised by the Provincial Government of Lucca, with support from the Regional Government of Tuscany – Brussels Headquarters, the Seminar shares the results of the IN-EUR project. The project, co-funded by the INTERREG IVC Programme has brought together 9 partners from 8 countries (Romania, Italy, Lithuania, Malta, Slovenia, Germany, France, Ireland) in a 3 year initiative of exchange, testing and policy development.

The heart of the project is the Advanced Local Balance of Innovation (ALBI) model, which represents a new tool for innovation policy making.

In addition to presenting the ALBI model and the results of the project, including the application of ALBI in 3 European areas with extensive stakeholder participation, the Working Seminar points to the future through open discussion among experts on the future of innovation measurement across the EU.
